



Additional Information

Parking

Patients and visitors are able to park in surface parking lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. Lots 1 and 2 have designated accessible parking spaces.

Additional accessible parking spaces can be found near the Emergency Department Entrance and Main Entrance.

Many parking options are available for patients and visitors including: daily passes; weekly and monthly consecutive day passes; and, non-consecutive use multi-day value passes. Parking rates are available on pay parking machines or from the Parking Office.

Please follow the parking payment instructions posted in the parking lots.

Visiting a Patient

Family members and friends are welcome to visit based on the patient's preferences, wishes and their safety.

Quiet time has been designated daily, from the hours of 10pm until 7am, to promote a restful environment for our patients.

Services & Amenities

A wide range of services are located in the hospital's Centre Block near the main lobby. This includes two retail food vendors with indoor and outdoor seating options, a drug store providing prescription services and a Volunteer Gift Shop featuring a variety of unique gifts.

Smoke-Free

Smoking is not permitted anywhere on hospital property, including inside personal vehicles while on the property.

The Halton Region Health Department actively enforces the Smoke-Free Ontario Act with enforcement officers which includes conducting random checks at the hospital to ensure compliance.

Fragrance-Free

Scented products can negatively affect people who are sensitive or have allergies. If you are coming to the hospital, please do not wear or use scented personal products. Scented personal products may include shampoos and conditioners, hairsprays, deodorants, colognes, aftershaves and perfumes.

Please do not bring in flower arrangements with highly fragrant flowers such as lilies.

Latex Safety

Latex products can be very dangerous for people with latex allergies. Please refrain from bringing products containing latex or natural rubber into the hospital. Examples include rubber balloons, rubber toys, hot water bottles. If in doubt, please check with the manufacturer.


