## 1. What is UVB Phototherapy?

#### 2. How do I get an appointment at the UVB Phototherapy Clinic?

You will need a doctor's referral for admission to UVB Clinic, see attached. Patients will be contacted by our clinic's RPN by phone to book an initial consultation appointment. After the initial assessment, further appointments will be arranged for you.

# 3. What is the wait time between the initial referral time and the first appointment?

Approximately 2-3 months depending on diagnosis.

### 4. What kinds of patients are accepted at the UVB Phototherapy Clinic?

We treat patients who have the following diagnoses:

- Psoriasis (non-scalp)
- Eczema
- CTCL
- Mycosis Fungoides
- Atopic dermatitis
- Pruritus
- Vitiligo
- Sezary Syndrome

#### 5. Is UVB Phototherapy covered by OHIP?

Yes it is OHIP covered, but parking is not covered. You also have to purchase a set of protective eye goggles, available for purchase at the UVB clinic.

# 6. What do I need to bring to an appointment?

Patients are expected to bring a list of all current medications, a valid health card, list of medical conditions, and money to purchase protective goggles.

# 7. How long will each treatment take to complete?

Each treatment takes 5-15 minutes to complete.
