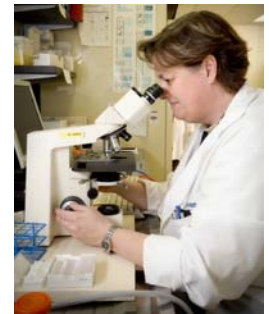


## Caring Today, Growing for Tomorrow

### Halton Healthcare Services



HHS is a progressive and vibrant multi-site healthcare organization serving the residents of Halton and Peel. In January 2006, Georgetown Hospital joined Oakville-Trafalgar Memorial Hospital and Milton District Hospital as part of Halton Healthcare Services. Together these hospitals provide healthcare services to more than 300,000 residents in the communities of Oakville, Milton and Halton Hills.

### Georgetown Hospital (GH)

GH was built in 1961 on 17 acres of land in the heart of Halton Hills. Offering a wide range of primary care services, its major clinical areas include obstetrics, general medicine, surgery and complex continuing care.

The hospital's Emergency and Diagnostic Imaging Departments are currently being renovated to respond to the need for these services and to create room for the Hospital's first CT Scanner.

### Our Mission

Our Mission – *to provide quality, compassionate care and services to meet the needs of our population in a timely and effective manner* – grows out of a culture of care and is shared by all our staff, physicians and volunteers. Supported by more than 2,800 employees, 1,100 volunteers and 300 family physicians and specialists, HHS ensures a consistent, coordinated approach to care.

### Poised For the Future

Situated in one of Canada's most desirable and fastest growing areas, HHS is poised to keep pace with the explosive population growth in southwestern Ontario with three hospital redevelopment projects underway.

HHS is expanding the Emergency and the Diagnostic Imaging Departments at Georgetown Hospital to accommodate the addition of a new CT scanner. We are also building a new hospital in Oakville as well as expanding the Milton District Hospital.

In 2011, HHS became formally affiliated with McMaster University to train medical residents and students at its three community hospitals.

We are also actively recruiting family physicians and specialists as well as nurses to join our medical team in providing care to our growing communities.





## Georgetown Hospital (GH)

The Hospital currently serves an urban and rural population of more than 59,000 and the population is expected to increase steadily over the next few years. HHS is expanding the Emergency and the Diagnostic Imaging Departments at Georgetown Hospital to accommodate the addition of a new CT scanner.

The Emergency Department, open 24 hours a day, seven days a week, experiences more than 32,000 emergency visits annually. The Obstetrics Unit at Georgetown Hospital site is a full service Level 1 facility. The Obstetrical Unit's labour, delivery and post partum beds can accommodate seven patients and currently delivers more than 400 babies each year. HHS has recently enhanced its orthopaedic program to include GH and now provides a full range of orthopaedic services to the residents of Halton Hills.

GH is supported by the Georgetown Hospital Volunteer Association whose adult and youth members contribute countless hours of service in many departments throughout the hospital and also raises funds toward the purchase of medical equipment.

The Georgetown Hospital Foundation's mission is to raise funds to enhance the healthcare services provided by Georgetown Hospital for the people of Halton Hills. The Foundation solicits and administers donations used to improve local hospital care through the purchase of medical equipment and enhancements to programs and facilities.

Georgetown Hospital is located in Halton Hills – a community that retains its ties to the past, is geared for the present and looks forward to a bright future. Halton Hills is the small town gem of the Greater Toronto Area.
