Candidates must be licensed to practice in Ontario and hold a specialist certificate in Anatomic or General Pathology from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. Subspecialty training/experience and previous working experience as a Pathologist in a community or academic centre are considered assets.

In rotation with other members in the Department, the successful candidate will provide on call coverage, general surgical pathology and cytopathology services, read peripheral blood smears and bone marrow aspirates, as well as cover a limited number of hospital autopsies. He/she will work at the Oakville, Milton and Georgetown hospitals.
