Halton Healthcare Services is looking for retail vendors for New Oakville Hospital

OAKVILLE - The construction of the New Oakville Hospital, located at the corner of Third Line and Dundas Street in Oakville, is proceeding on schedule to meet the December 2015 opening date.

In addition to having capacity for 457 beds and offering a number of new programs to the community, the new 1.6 million square foot state-of-the-art hospital also has space for 18 retail opportunities that will help enhance the patient and visitor experience.

On July 29, 2014 Halton Healthcare Services (HHS) issued a Request For Proposals (RFP) for the retail space located within the New Oakville Hospital. Units range from 140 square feet to 5,000 square feet, targeting food, pharmacy and other retail vendors. HHS has appointed Carillion Services (HIP) Inc. to manage the procurement process on their behalf.

The new hospital is patient and family focussed and will offer many new features that are not currently available at the existing hospital. Ample parking is located close to entrances and is fully accessible to public transport, bike paths, and trails.

“This is a fantastic opportunity for vendors to be able to not only reach our patients and visitors with their services, but to also reach over 2,000 staff and physicians that work on site each day,” says Kinga Sharma, Director of Business Development at HHS. “We are very excited about being able to offer this space and provide additional services to the residents of Halton.”
