Responsibilities:

- Providing GIM consults on inpatients
- Serving as MRP for Level 2 ICU inpatients
- Covering Post Discharge Clinic
- Participating in on-call coverage for GIM proportionate to weeks worked averaging no more than 1:5
- Minimum commitment of 6 weeks of coverage per year.
- Day time schedule - one week (Monday to Sunday) at a time. Potential role for locums prior to start.
- There may be opportunities for stress tests, pulmonary function tests and GIM admissionist roles.
